

basis for approximately 10 years.

BIBR believes prayer is essential to seeing lives changed. BIBR's core values are to provide Christbased instruction, restoration, and counseling to transform the heart, minds, and communities of the incarcerated. There is a change process that begins

while they are in prison and extends beyond their release. That allows them to become responsible leaders in their families, churches, and communities.

BIBR believes, "Three things will last forever-faith, hope, and love – and the greatest of these is love", 1 Corinthians 13:13.
"Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for
