Maywood has supported Bill and Carol Turner since January of 1996 where they were first ministering in the Arab Emirates. Recently, Bill Turner came to give us an update on their work during our second Missionary Emphasis Sunday this past month.

After 23 years in the Arab Emirates, Bill and Carol came back to the U.S. in 2019, and had to determine where they would live and find adequate schooling for their daughter, Tealah. They settled in Tennessee where several of their children currently live. Previous to their move, Bill had been involved in writing several courses that he began to use in the field. Two such programs were shared entitled: Disciple-Making Movements (DMM) and Discovery Bible Study (DBS). These programs were described to us as effective personal evangelism tools to use to lead people to Christ.

Co-workers invited Bill to consider going to Africa in order to train pastors there in these programs. In 2022, the Lord prompted Bill to go to Uganda and we have been reading of the many adventures he has experienced during his travels there.

While in Africa, Bill was introduced to Pastor Franco, a former Muslim, who was led to Christ by a Christian fisherman when he was 11 years old. Pastor Franco and Bill became fast friends. Pastor Franco started 13 churches in Uganda and has the unique gift of being fluent in five different languages. During Bill's time in Rwanda, the Lord closed doors of entrance into the Congo, but the impact in training multiple, large groups in the DMM program proved to be advantageous and a great encouragement to both Pastor Franco, and the many pastors and leaders of the churches there.

We were thankful to hear from Bill as he visits and stays with relatives in the Kansas City area and look forward to news about his next trip to Africa.
